- in the absence of results of maturity examination at state or school level, the final year's grade obtained in this subject will be taken into account,
- non-scoring additional criterion - Polish language grade on the maturity diploma (final year grade accepted),
- if there is no grade in the Polish language on the maturity diploma, the candidate has to pass a Polish language test.

In the case of candidates with citizenships other than Polish or Lithuanian, the Rector, in consultation with the director of the branch office, makes the decision on enrolment.

Method of converting points:

- the result of the maturity examination expressed in points constitutes the number of points in the admission procedure,
- the school-leaving examination result expressed in points constitutes the number of points in the admission procedure (applies to school-leaving certificates obtained before 2011). The final year marks obtained on the maturity diploma expressed in points (in the absence of a state or school examination result) are divided by 2,
- the maximum number of points obtained in a single subject is 100.

Secondary school certificate obtained before 1990:

The results of the maturity examination and the final grades obtained on the maturity diploma expressed in points are multiplied by 2.

Subjects taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the basis for recruitment is the result of maturity examination in history or mathematics
 - school or state level,
- in the absence of a result in the maturity examination in history at state or school level, the final grade obtained in this subject on the maturity diploma will be taken into account,
- non-scoring additional criterion - Polish language grade on the maturity diploma (final year grade accepted),
- if there is no grade in the Polish language on the maturity diploma, the candidate has to pass a Polish language test.

In the case of candidates with citizenships other than Polish or Lithuanian, the Rector, in consultation with the director of the branch office, makes the decision on enrolment.

Method of converting points:

- the result of the maturity examination expressed in points constitutes the number of points in the admission procedure,
- the school-leaving examination result expressed in points constitutes the number of points in the admission procedure (applies to maturity diplomas obtained before 2011),
- the final year grades obtained on the maturity diploma expressed in points (in the absence of a state or school examination result) are divided by 2,
- the maximum number of points obtained in a single subject is 100.

Secondary school certificate obtained before 1990:

The results of the maturity examination and the final grades obtained on the maturity

diploma expressed in points are multiplied by 2.
