## The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade awarded on the diploma of completion of a first-cycle programme (second-cycle programme or long-cycle master's programme) in a subject belonging to the humanities or social sciences,
- arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.


## 2. Programme: Security and law

## The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade awarded on the diploma of completion of a first-cycle programme (second-cycle programme or long-cycle master's programme) in a subject belonging to the humanities or social sciences,
- arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.


## 3. Programme: Biology

## The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade for the first-cycle (second-cycle or long-cycle) diploma in the following disciplines: biological sciences, earth and environmental sciences, pharmaceutical sciences, medical sciences, health sciences, forestry sciences, agriculture and horticulture, food and nutrition technology, veterinary medicine, zootechnics and fisheries, biomedical engineering, chemical engineering, environmental engineering, mining and energy,
- arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.


## 4. Programme: Chemistry

The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade awarded on the diploma of completion of a first-cycle programme (second-cycle programme or long-cycle programme) in a subject belonging to the disciplines of chemical sciences, pharmaceutical sciences, medical sciences, health sciences, biomedical engineering, chemical engineering,
- arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.


## 5. Programme: Forensic chemistry

The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade awarded on the diploma of completion of first-cycle studies (secondcycle studies or long-cycle studies) in disciplines belonging to: biological sciences, chemical sciences, physical sciences, pharmaceutical sciences, medical sciences, health sciences, biomedical engineering, chemical engineering),
- $\quad$ arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.


## 6. Programme: Economics

The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade on the first-cycle diploma (second-cycle diploma or long-cycle master's degree),
- arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.

Candidates who do not have the following subjects in their diploma supplement (completed course of study): microeconomics I and II, mathematics, econometrics I, will be required to complete these courses during their first year of study.

## 7. Programme: Economics - practical profile (Faculty of Economics and

 Information Technology in Vilnius)The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade awarded on the first-cycle diploma (second-cycle studies or longcycle master's studies or other studies at a level corresponding to level 6 or 7 of the European Qualifications Framework) in courses belonging to the social sciences,
- the arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies,
- the Polish language test result - for candidates who have completed their firstcycle studies, second-cycle studies or long-cycle studies in a language other than Polish, or who do not have a Polish language mark in their maturity diploma (criterion not scored).


## 8. Programme: Philology

## Specialisation module: English philology

(Educational offer for first-cycle graduates with English language skills at a C1 level)
The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade on the first-cycle diploma (second-cycle or long-cycle master's degree) in English philology or filed of study within the scope of English philology,
- the arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies,
- the result of a obligatory interview at a C1 language in the case of candidates who have not completed a first-cycle course in English philology or field of study within the scope of English philology.


## 9. Programme: Philology

## Specialisation module: English philology with elements of translation studies

(Educational offer for graduates of first-cycle studies with knowledge of English at a C1 level and interested in acquiring knowledge and skills in the field of translation) The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade on the first-cycle diploma (second-cycle or long-cycle master's degree) in English philology or filed of study within the scope of English philology,
- the arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies,
- the result of a obligatory interview at a C1 language in the case of candidates who have not completed a first-cycle course in English philology or field of study within the scope of English philology.
In the case of foreign applicants, proof of proficiency in C2 proficiency in the Polish language is required.


## 10. Programme: Philology

## Specialisation module: Russian philology - translation studies

(Educational offer for first degree graduates with C1 level Russian language skills interested in acquiring knowledge and skills in translation)

## The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

For first-cycle graduates in Russian philology:

- the grade on the graduation diploma,
- $\quad$ arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.

For graduates in other fields of study in the humanities who demonstrate a working knowledge of Russian at C1 level according to the Council of Europe's Common European Framework of Reference for Languages:

- a grade in the entrance examination in Russian in philological knowledge (firstcycle programme).


## 11. Programme: Foreign Language Philology, teaching

The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade on the first-cycle diploma in English philology, in Russian philology or in diploma in other studies in English or Russian philology,
- arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.


## 12. Programme: Polish philology

The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade on the first-cycle diploma (second-cycle diploma or single master's degree) in a subject belonging to the humanities or social sciences,
- the arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies,
- the result of an obligatory interview for persons who have not graduated in Polish philology.


## 13. Programme: Polish philology, teaching

The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade for the first-cycle diploma in Polish philology,
- $\quad$ arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.


## 14. Programme: Philosophy

## The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade on a first-cycle diploma (either a second-cycle diploma or a longcycle master's degree) in a field of study belonging to one of the following sciences: humanities, social sciences, sciences and natural sciences, medical and health sciences, theological sciences, arts,
- arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.


## 15. Programme: Physics

## The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade on the diploma of completion of first-cycle studies (second-cycle studies or long-cycle master's studies) in fields belonging to engineering and technical sciences or disciplines: medical sciences, astronomy, computer science, mathematics, chemical sciences, physical sciences, earth and environmental sciences,
- arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.


## 16. Programme: History

## The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the mark awarded on the diploma of completion of first-cycle studies (secondcycle studies or long-cycle studies) in the following disciplines: history, archaeology, philosophy, linguistics, cultural and religious sciences, art sciences, security sciences, legal sciences, sociological sciences, pedagogy, psychology, canon law, political and administrative sciences, social communication and media sciences, economics and finance,
- arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.


## 17. Programme: Computer Science

The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- Grade on a first-cycle diploma in information technology or a first-cycle diploma (a second-cycle diploma or a long-cycle master's degree) in fields of science, natural sciences or engineering and technical sciences where the leading discipline is computer science or information technology and telecommunications, or in fields of study where the share of the disciplines computer science or information technology and telecommunications is at least 40\%,
- $\quad$ arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.


## 18. Programme: Criminology

## The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the mark awarded on the diploma of completion of a first-cycle programme (second-cycle programme or long-cycle master's programme) in a subject belonging to the humanities or social sciences,
- arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.


## 19. Programme: Cultural studies

## The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- $\quad$ the grade on the first-cycle diploma (second-cycle diploma or long-cycle master's degree),
- $\quad$ arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.


## 20. Programme: Mathematics

## The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- $\quad$ the grade awarded on the diploma of completion of first-cycle studies (secondcycle studies or long-cycle studies) in subjects belonging to the following disciplines: mathematics, physical sciences, computer science, automatics, electronics and electrical engineering, technical and telecommunications informatics, biomedical engineering, chemical engineering, materials engineering, mechanical engineering, environmental engineering,
- arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.


## 21. Programme: International economic relations

The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade on the first-cycle diploma (second-cycle diploma or long-cycle master's degree),
- $\quad$ arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.

Candidates who do not have the following subjects in their Diploma Supplement (completed course of study): mathematics, economics I and II, descriptive statistics, will be required to complete these during their first year of study.

## 24. Programme: Social work

## The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade awarded on the diploma of completion of a first-cycle programme (second-cycle programme or long-cycle master's programme) in a subject belonging to the humanities or social sciences,
- $\quad$ arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.


## 25. Programme: Sociology

The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade awarded on the diploma of completion of first-cycle studies (secondcycle studies or long-cycle studies) in fields belonging to the humanities, social sciences, theology, arts or the discipline of architecture and urban planning, health sciences,
- arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.

Candidates who do not have the subjects Fundamentals of Management and Marketing in their Diploma Supplement (completed course of study) will be required to complete these during their first year of study.
