- In the absence of an English language score/assessment, the candidate will take an oral examination in English at B1 level.

Candidates who passed the European Baccalaureate (EB):

- the basis for recruitment is the result of the matriculation examination in English - basic or extended level.

Candidates who passed the International Baccalaureate (IB):

- recruitment is based on the result of the baccalaureate exam in English - lower (standard) level (SL) or higher level (HL).

Candidates holding a document obtained abroad, entitling them to study at university:

- recruitment is based on an English language score/assessment.

In the absence of an English language score/assessment, the candidate will take an oral examination in English at B1 level.

- a first-cycle diploma in information technology or a first-cycle diploma (a second-cycle diploma or long-cycle master's degree) in fields of science, natural sciences or engineering and technical sciences where the leading discipline is computer science or information technology and telecommunications, or in fields of study where the share of the disciplines: computer science or information technology and telecommunications is at least 40%,
- the arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.

2.2. Programme: International Economic

Relations Studies conducted in English

The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade on the first-cycle diploma (second-cycle diploma or long-cycle master's degree),
- the arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.

2.3. Programme: International

Relations Studies conducted in English

The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- the grade on the first-cycle diploma (second-cycle diploma or long-course master's degree) in any field of study,
- the arithmetic mean of the grades from the studies.

2.4. Programme: Philology

Specialisation module: English

**Philology Studies conducted in
English**

The following will be taken into account in the admission procedure:

- a diploma of completion of a first-cycle, second-cycle or long-cycle master's degree (or equivalent) in a subject belonging to the humanities,
- a certificate in English of at least B2+ level.

If the candidate does not have a B2+ level English certificate, the candidate will take a B2+ level English oral exam.
